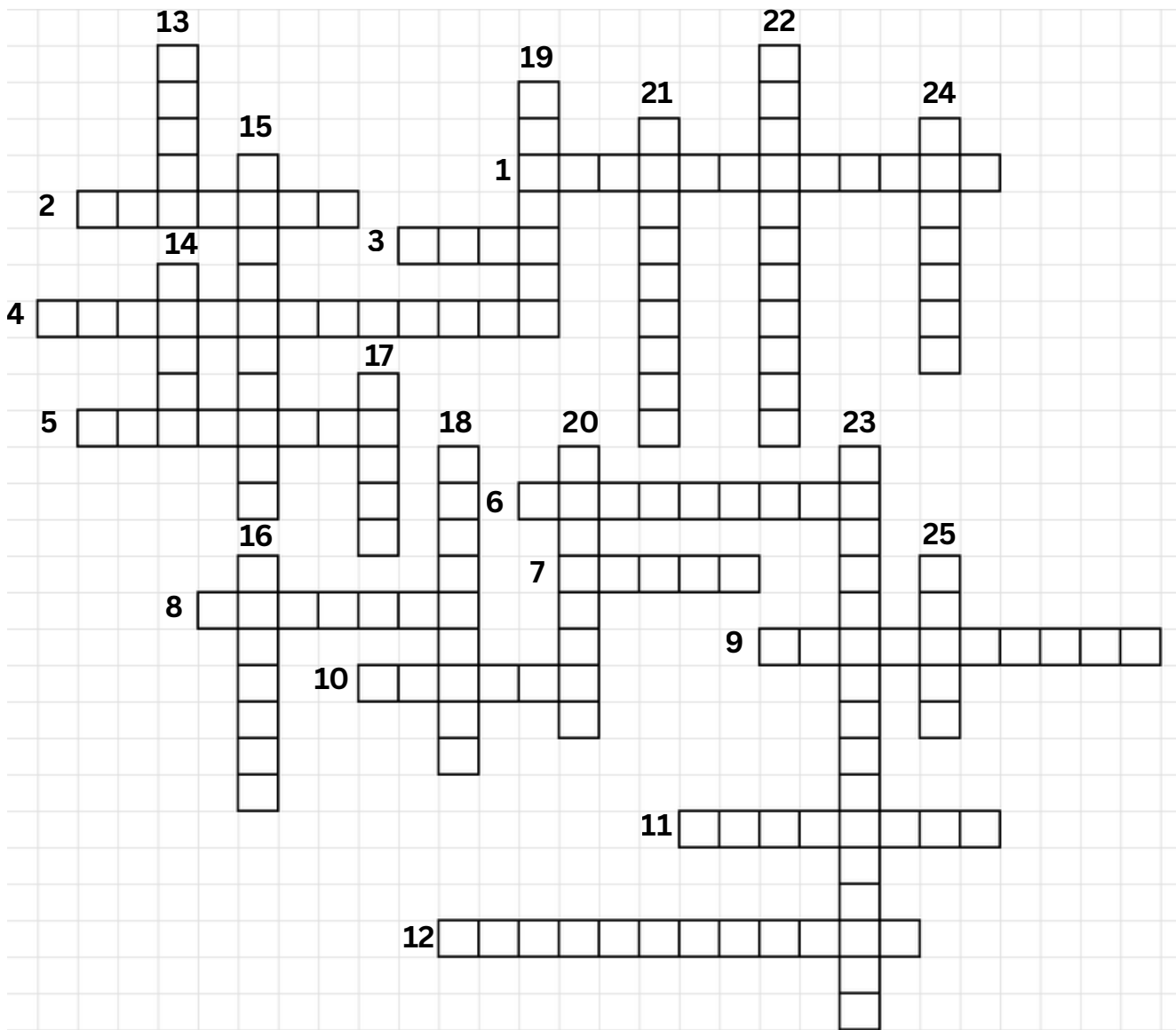


The library is celebrating its 60th anniversary!
