



Getting started with Hoopla on your computer

Hoopla is a digital media service that allows library members to stream videos, music, audiobooks and comic books to their computer, or download titles to their tablet or smartphone app. Members can borrow up to 5 items per month.

Step 1: Create a Hoopla account

1) Visit www.csllibrary.org/ebooksandmore

Step 2: Browse the library's Hoopla collection and borrow a title.

 From the top left corner, you will be able to Browse the collection by format (Audiobooks, Movies, Music, etc.). Click on the category that interests you to browse through titles.



2) To search for a specific title, artist or series, click in the **search box** at the top of the page. Enter the name of a book, movie, author, tv series, etc.



3) Click on the title that interests you from the drop-down menu.







4) Locate your title and click on it to get more information.



5) Click on **Borrow** to borrow the title.

6) Click Read / Play to read, listen, or watch the title.



Step 3: Return a title

1) To return a title, click on **My Hoopla** from the top left corner. Click **currently borrowed**.







2) Click on the item you would like to return. (Do not click on the play button).



3) Click Return Now.

Once borrowed, the return date of the item is displayed. It will be automatically removed from your account on this date (3 days for **movies** & **TV shows**; 7 days for **music** albums; 21 days for **e-books**, **audiobooks** and **comics**) at 8:00 pm. There is no risk of late fees.

There is a monthly borrowing limit of five titles; borrowing limits automatically reset on the first of each calendar month; any unused check-outs do not carry over to the next month. You can return a **Borrowed** item early but it will not give you another checkout for that month. The only reason to return an item early would be to free-up space on your device.
