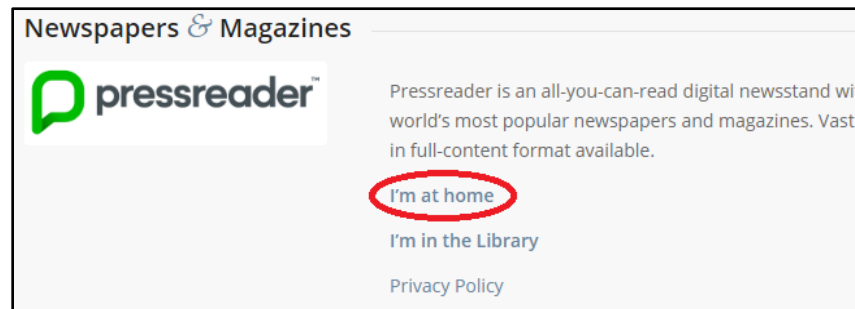


Getting Started with *PressReader* on a browser

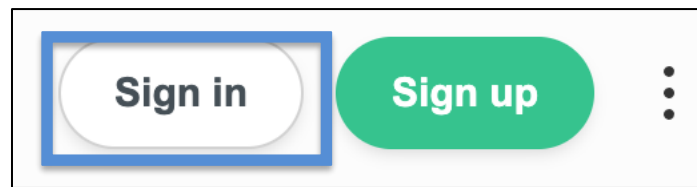
Pressreader is an all-you-can-read digital newsstand with thousands of the world's most popular newspapers and magazines with a vast selection of top stories in full-content.

Step 1: Log in to Pressreader

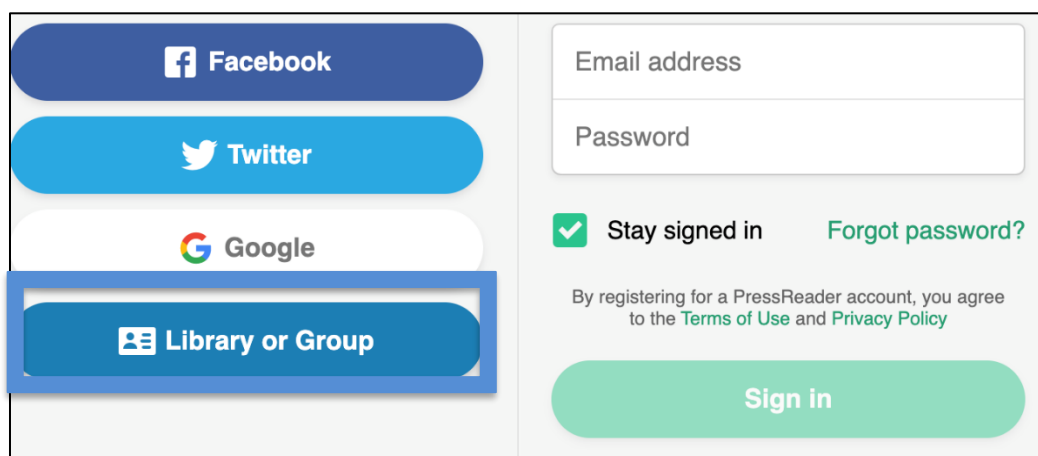
- 1) Visit www.csllibrary.org/ebooksandmore
- 2) Scroll down to find the Pressreader logo and click *I'm at home*




- 3) Click *Sign In* in the top-right corner of your screen.




- 4) Choose *Library or Group*.



- 5) Enter “côte saint-luc” in the search bar and select *Bibliothèque Côte Saint-Luc Public Library*.



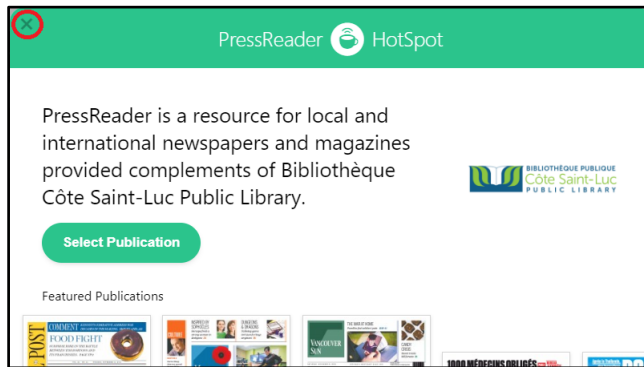
- 6) Click *Sign in*.



- 7) Enter your name and your 14-digit library card number and click *Login*.

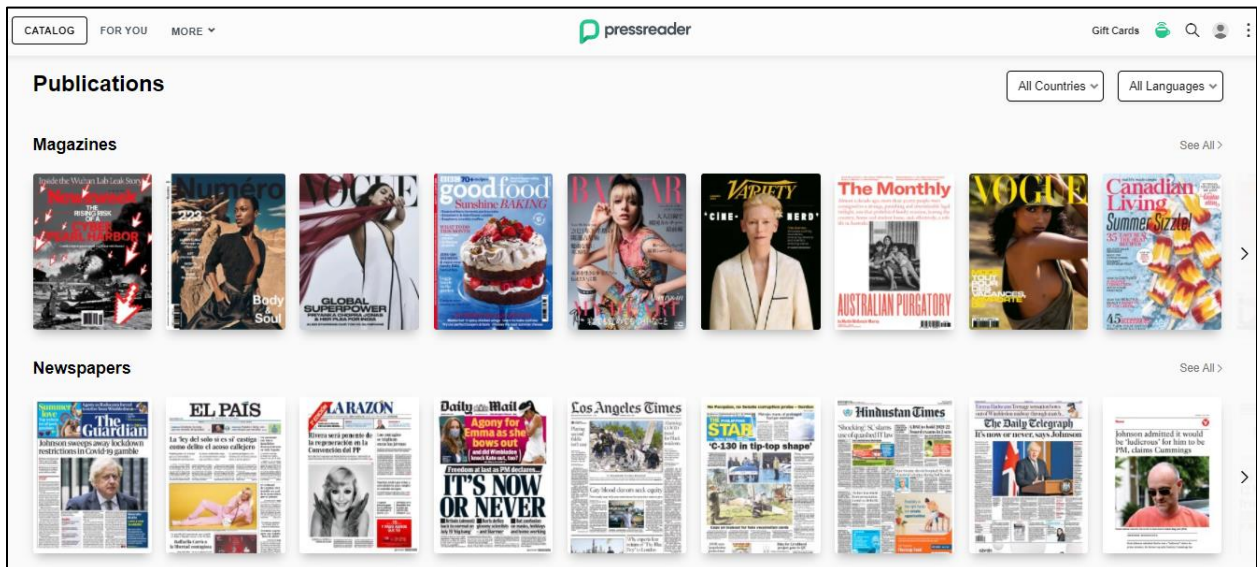


- 8) Close the PressReader HotSpot pop-up message.

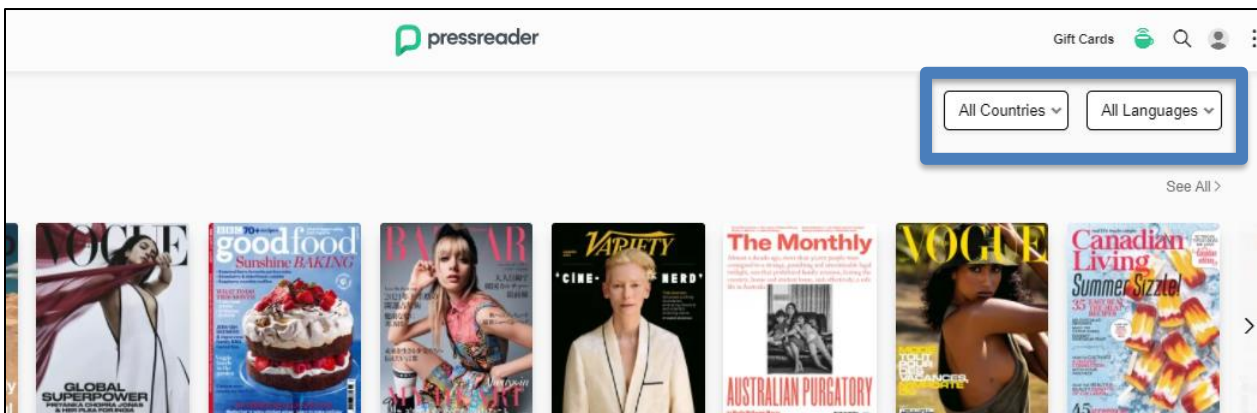


Step 2: Browse or search the catalog

1) You can scroll through the main page to browse the Pressreader catalog.



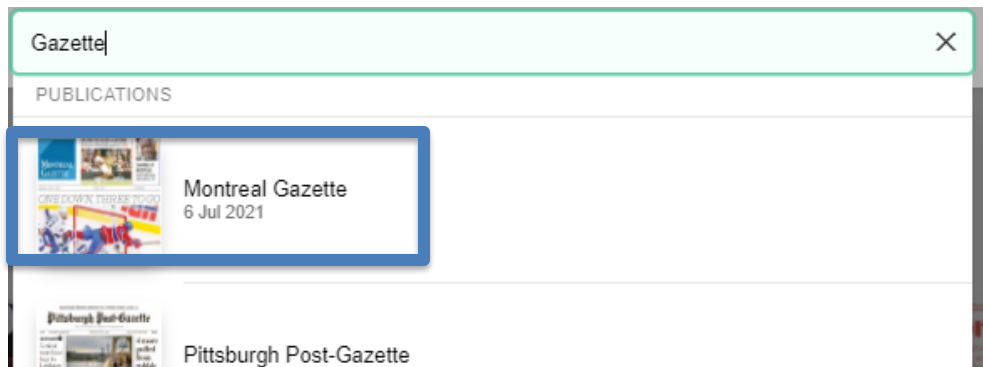
2) You can filter the collection by country or language.



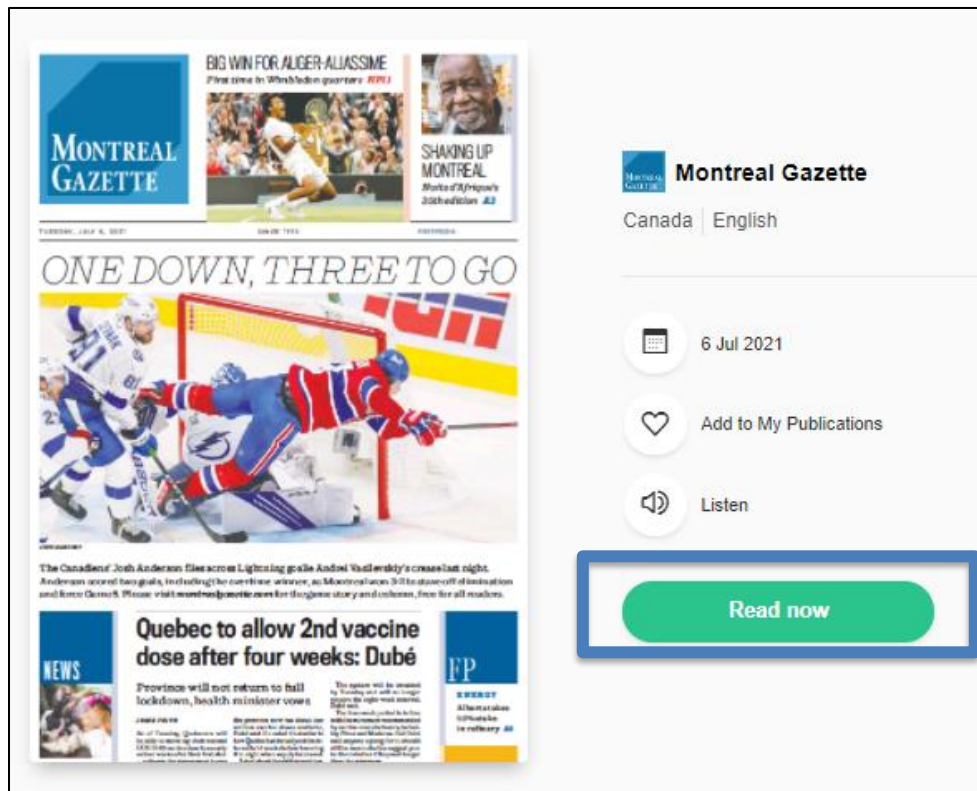
- 3) Press on the magnifying glass from the top-right corner to search for a specific publication.



- 4) In the search box, type in the title of the publication and select the publication from the drop-down menu.



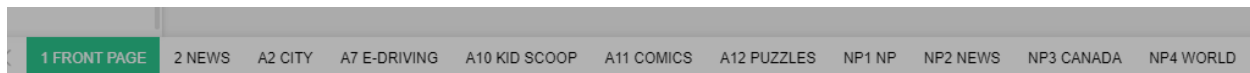
- 5) Press **Read now** to read the latest issue.



- 6) You can also read previous issues of the publication. Hover your mouse over the covers to see the date of publication. Click on desired one and then click **Read Now**.



- 7) In the publication, you can navigate through the table of contents at the bottom.



- 8) Slide your mouse right to left to scroll through the publication. You can click on a specific article to have a more detailed view of it.

VERY IMPORTANT: Once the complementary access (of a few days) has expired, you will need to **Log in AGAIN** to the PressReader website (with your name and barcode) through our library's digital collections page (www.csllibrary.org).
